After graduating from University College, London, Lynton became a criminal law specialist. Over the past year Lynton has, as a litigator, represented many clients in the Crown Court and above. Just one notable case was acting on behalf of the lead Defendant in Operation Rize, a multi-million pound case linked to the use of safe deposit boxes which arose out of the biggest operation ever mounted by the Metropolitan Police.

Lynton has a growing advocacy practice where he has been led on a £6 million oil fraud. As a sole junior advocate Lynton has successfully defended many clients, including a Chinese Businessman involved in the fraudulent use of a €25 billion bank guarantee purportedly issued by the Royal Bank of Scotland.

Lynton is a committee member of the Society of Black Lawyers and the Solicitor's Association of Higher Court Advocates. Each year Lynton assists the International Lawyers Project in giving courses, and helping to implement, legal training in developing countries.
